## RULES & REGULATIONS:

**ELIGIBILITY:** This event is open to all chess players of any nationality and any strength.

**LAST DATE OF ENTRY:** Entries can be sent on or before 30<sup>th</sup> November 2012.

**ENTRY FEE:** Entry fee of the tournament is Rs. 1,500/-. Entry forms along with entry fee and registration fee for 2012 and/or 2013 payable by demand draft in favour of "Chess Association of India" payable at Lucknow can be sent to S.K. Tewari, Organizing Secretary, 638/3-A, Shivpuri Colony, Picnic Spot Road, P.O. CIMAP, Lucknow 226015, U.P. Physically challenged, veterans (over 60 years of age as on 01.01.2012) and North Eastern States players will be entitled for 50% discount in entry fee. However, there will be no discount in CAI Registration fee of Rs.100/-. After 30.11.2012 entry will be accepted up-to 5.00 PM on 15<sup>th</sup> December 2012 with a late fee of Rs. 500/- per player. But after 30.11.2012 the players not registered with CAI for the current year will be charged entry fee of Rs. 3,000/- apart from registration as well as late fee. However, entries may be accepted upto 10.00 AM on 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2012 with a late fee of Rs. 1,000/-, subject to space availability.

Entry fee can also be deposited in CAI Core Banking A/c No. 353302010819861 with Union Bank of India, Clarks Avadh Branch, Lucknow. IFSC Code UBIN 0535338. But in that case scanned copy of bank deposit slip must be sent before last date of entry fee to Mr. S. K. Entry fee once paid is not refundable.

Entry for GM/WGM/IM/WIM will be free.

**REGISTRATION:** CAI Registration is must for all Indian players.

**NOTE:** For Indian participants payment of CAI registration fee for 2013 is mandatory.

## IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS:

Use of electronic devices inside the tournament hall is strictly prohibited. Mobiles, even in switch off mode, will not be allowed inside the tournament hall and players found violating this instruction will lose their point.

Use of alcohol, cigarette, pan mashala, etc. inside the venue are strictly prohibited and will be tantamount indiscipline.

Every player must attend the prize distribution ceremony, otherwise their prizes/participation certificates will be withheld.

**ACCOMMODATION:** Free dormitory accommodation will be provided to outstation players who confirm their entry before 30.11.2012. Entry will be treated confirmed only when entry fee is deposited before last date of entry. Since we have limited accommodation it will be provided on first come first serve basis. Accompanying person will be provided accommodation on payment of Rs. 1,000/- subject to availability, otherwise they have to make their own arrangement.

## **Lucknow (Capital of Uttar Pradesh) - India**

This lovely city is the capital of UP and has been Synonymous with Chess, a cradle of civilization and one of the most educated cities in India with a literacy rate of 75%.

Lucknow is a Historical Place. In the Monuments of Lucknow the glorious golden era of Avadh has been expressed by commencing a tour through the famous buildings built in those times. The buildings of Lucknow reflect a classes of their own. Even the splendid, huge and wonderful buildings have been constructed with small brick plates popularly known as 'Lakhauri', pair of fishes, beautiful symmetrical arches, Baradaris and Naubatkhanas.

A number of monuments are main attractions for tourists here. Great Bara Imambara, Chhota Imambara, Residency and Shahnajaf Imambara are monuments of architectural importance. The famous 'Bhul Bhulaiyan' (Labyrinth) is part of Asafi (Bara) Imambara complex. Some other places of interest are the Shaheed Smarak, Dilkusha Garden, Ambedkar Park, Lohia Park, Planetarium, Beautiful Vidhan Bhawan (State Legislative Assembly Building), the Clock Tower and the Charbagh Railway Station. In Hazratganj area, St Joseph's Cathedral is the seat of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Lucknow.

Lucknow is famous for its unique styles of embroidery namely, Chikan and Lakhnawi Zardozi, both of which are significant foreign exchange earners. Chikan has caught the fancy of fashion designers in Bollywood and Abroad.

Lucknow is regarded as one of the finest cities of India. It represents a culture that combines emotional warmth, a high degree of sophistication, courtesy and love for gracious living. It is a center of Hindi and Urdu literature (Ganga-Jamuni Tehzeeb).

Today, Lucknow is a city that is witnessing an economic boom and is among the top ten fastest growing non-major-metropolitan cities of India.

Lucknow has a warm humid subtropical climate with cool, dry winters from December to February and dry, hot summers from April to June. In winter the maximum temperature is around 25 degrees Celsius (77 °F) and the minimum is in the 4 to 5 degrees Celsius range. Fog is quite common from late December to late January.
